Walk out to the sidewalk and objectively look at your home! Could you sell it for the maximum price possible? Does the mailbox need repair? Are the gutters sagging? Please make an effort to pick up trash and clean the curb area immediately in front of your own property.

LOOKS GOOD	NEEDS ATTENTION
Display House address numbers (4" high) on house, mailbox, curb, etc.	
Grass cut (maintained at 5" or less, even when absent)	
Lawn edged	
Grass & weeds removed from cracks in driveways, walkways and curbs	
Shrubs, hedges and trees trimmed (especially by sidewalks/right/aways)	
<i>Dead</i> trees, shrubs and limbs removed (Wednesday pickup during spring/summer)	
YOU are responsible for cleaning-up after your pet	
Outside security lights aim low for safety of vehicles passing house	
Dispose of debris removed from premises (trash, construction debris, etc.)	
Trash receptacles covered and stored between collections	
Beautification of area (replace broken Newspaper Boxes, Post and mail boxes, etc.)	
Dispose of building/construction debris	
Replace broken/damaged doors, windows, screens, antennas	
Repair/remove/replace broken or rotted wood on home	
Refinish/replace home surfaces with cracked or peeling paint/vinyl	
Rust removed from exposed metal and repainted	
Appliances, toys and tools stored indoors/out-of-sight	
Firewood neatly stacked	
Garden hoses rolled or stored indoors	
Garage doors closed when not in use	
No auto repair, changing oil, or disposing of oil in the Community	
Unregistered vehicles garaged or removed from property	
No cars park on grass or on blocks	
Snow must be shoveled from sidewalks	
Recycling bins stored out-of-sight between collection days

Use recycle bins for clean glass, paper, cardboard, metal – DO NOT use for other tra	ısh
Remove any commercial trucks
